Day 1: Friday, May 7, 2021 Philadelphia, PA - Tour Begins

Welcome to Philadelphia. Your spring tour blends some of the city's most popular and iconic destinations during a special time of the year.

Day 2: Saturday, May 8, 2021 Philadelphia - Nemours Mansion -Longwood Gardens - Philadelphia Your day opens with a visit to the

Your day opens with a visit to the Nemours Mansion and Gardens. Created in the late 1800s, the 200-acre estate is home to a sprawling mansion and the country's largest formal French gardens. Afterwards, visit Longwood Gardens. Spreading over an area of 1,077 acres, Longwood Gardens has a seemingly endless collection of indoor and outdoor gardens. (*B*, *D*)

Day 3: Sunday, May 9, 2021
Philadelphia - Lancaster Discover the "Birthplace of a New Nation" and visit the Liberty Bell and Independence Hall. Continue to the Reading Terminal Market, which has housed local and international produce since the 19th century. In addition to fresh fruits, you'll find elegant linens, colorful bouquets, and more. As the day draws to a close, depart for the beautiful Amish Country of Lancaster.

Day 4: Monday, May 10, 2021 Lancaster - Strasburg - Lancaster

Begin the day with a visit to Wheatland,* the former home of President James Buchanan. Spend time in the Amish Kitchen Kettle Village before venturing out to the farmlands with a local guide. Get a peek into cultural customs and enjoy traditional cuisine at dinner, joined by members of the local Amish community**. (B, D)





Day 5: Tuesday, May 11, 2021
Lancaster - Paradise - Lancaster Visit an authentic Amish store and peruse a collection of handmade furniture and quilts. Discover Landis Valley Village and Farm Museum, set on a ground of 100 acres. With costumed guides, delve into historic German heritage and the essence of Pennsylvania Dutch life. (*B*, *D*)

Day 6: Wednesday, May 12, 2021 Lancaster - Gettysburg - Lancaster Visit the Gettysburg National Military Park and Museum. Begin your tour with the short film A New Birth of Freedom. Immerse yourself into the past with Paul Philippoteaux's Cyclorama from 1884, a breathtaking 360° cylindrical painting depicting Pickett's Charge. Make your way through the Museum of the American Civil War and its galleries. Step onto the legendary battlefield with a guided tour of the site, illuminating the infamous days in 1863 and the decisive battle that changed the course of American history. Then, it's your **choice!** Visit President Eisenhower's home and farm, which served as the

President's weekend retreat and a meeting place for world leaders during the Cold War-era tensions **OR**-embark on a guided walking tour of historic downtown Gettysburg with a local expert dressed in period clothing. Tonight, return to Lancaster for an evening at leisure. (*B*)

Day 7: Thursday, May 13, 2021
Lancaster - Hershey - Lancaster Your day begins with a trip to Hershey's Chocolate World, USA, where you will enjoy a tasting experience. Visit the Hershey Story Museum to learn more about the life of the Hershey Family. Visit Founders Hall at the Milton Hershey School. This afternoon you will have the opportunity to enjoy free time in Lancaster or take the opportunity to shop at the QVC Outlet. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for dinner. (*B*, *D*)

Day 8: Friday, May 14, 2021 Lancaster - Philadelphia - Tour Ends The memories of this historic tour are sure to stay with you forever. (*B*)

On this hallowed ground, in a small Pennsylvania town in 1863, two armies met to decide the fate of a nation. After his victory at Chancellorsville, Robert E. Lee set out to invade the North and was met by the Army of the Potomac. The brutal encounter that followed became known as the Battle of Gettysburg. Join us as we explore the battlefield on a guided tour that brings to life these dramatic events. Watch as the stories you may have heard in history class about Little Round Top and Pickett's Charge come to life.

Please Note: IDENTIFICATION

Travel within USA

For travel completed by September 30, 2020, all airlines will ask for identification when you check in. It is recommended that you carry a passport if you have one. A driver's license (with a photo I.D.) is also acceptable for domestic flights.

Effective for travel October 1, 2020 forward, the REAL ID Act standards for identification while travelling will be in effect. This means a standard issued driver's license used as a form of identification will no longer be accepted for domestic air travel within the United States. Instead, a Real ID compliant form of identification must be presented both at the time of booking air travel with Collette and

upon checking in at the airport to board any flight. Any fees associated with changing a reservation resulting from a non-compliant identification will be the responsibility of the guest. To complete your tour, we <u>include</u> roundtrip airport-to-hotel transfers when purchasing our airfare with your tour. If you have arranged for your own air, we are pleased to provide

you the option of *purchasing* these transfers. Please note that all transfers will leave at pre-scheduled times. Single accommodations are limited and are available on a first come, first served basis.

The order of sightseeing may change to best utilize your time on tour.

The overall activity level of this tour is a level 2. This means you like a balanced approach to travel. You feel confident walking at least 30-45 minutes at a time over a variety of terrains – from cobblestone streets to easy straightaways to a couple hills or flights of stairs. You're comfortable walking a few city blocks at a time, but need some time to unwind and relax.
